## At a Glance

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## Our Program

At the Junior Campus, we provide a wonderful array of activities for our campers. They are busy and engaged throughout each day. The campers are placed into groups according to their ages, which allows us to tailor each camper's experience most effectively.

The daily schedule includes both outdoor and indoor activities, allowing campers to enjoy the Miami summer while helping keep them cool. Moreover, our swimming program provides each camper with both instructional and recreational swimming opportunities on a daily basis. The pool is one of the most popular spots on campus, and over the years we have taught thousands of children to swim.

Our program features an incredible video arcade and game room, a bounce house, bumper boats, ping pong, arts \& crafts, electric cars, a playroom, board games, and sports such as basketball, soccer, box hockey, tennis, kickball, and more. One thing is for sure - there is something for everyone. Each camper will be able to explore a variety of activities in a safe and nurturing setting.

Campers are also entertained with a weekly movie and a variety of special events like Color War, Talent Shows, and Bingo. Additionally, each session campers are scheduled for a field trip. Campers of ages $3-5$ have "on-campus" field trips, and campers entering grades 1 and 2 travel off campus for their field trips.

In addition to the vast range of sports and activities incorporated into each schedule, campers entering first and second grade are able to choose a special activity each week. The activity becomes a part of the camper's daily schedule and can include athletics, karate, woodworking, karaoke, leather crafts, engineering, dance, drama, art, computer games, cheerleading, t-shirt painting, and more.

[^1]The Senior Campus program at Riviera is both balanced and varied in a way that gives every camper the opportunity to pursue his or her personal interests. Riviera allows campers to focus on and develop skills as if they were in a specialty camp while providing campers with a traditional camping experience, helping them build camaraderie and providing an array of activities.

## Entering Grade 3 - Grade 5

These campers have a structured and well-rounded program which incorporates various elements, exposing children to sports, the arts, swimming (daily), and many other fun activities. In addition to required group activities, all campers sign up for "Clinics" and "Selectives." "Clinics" are areas of focus and are offered in Basketball, Soccer, Lacrosse, Theater, Dance, Art, and Volleyball. "Clinics" are chosen by the family for each camp session upon enrollment. "Selectives" are chosen by the campers during camp and provide the opportunity to focus further within their "Clinic" choice or to explore additional areas of interest. Field Trips and Special Events further enhance each session.

## Entering Grade 6 - Grade 10

These campers are able to customize their schedules by choosing what they want through "Clinics" and "Selectives." A portion of their day will be spent in "Clinics" which are areas of focus chosen by their family for each session upon enrollment. "Clinic" areas are Basketball, Soccer, Lacrosse, Theater, Dance, Art, and Volleyball. "Selectives" also provide campers with the opportunity to choose activities that they enjoy. "Selectives" allow campers to focus even further within their "Clinic" area or in any number of other areas and activities. Moreover, all campers will have a chance to cool down and swim on a daily basis. Field Trips and Special Events complete the overall experience.
